Comprehensive Emergency Preparedness

Lake Lavon Camp operates under a detailed Emergency Action Plan that guides our response to a wide range of situations. Our leadership team regularly reviews and practices these procedures to ensure a prompt, coordinated, and effective response in the unlikely event of an emergency. We also conduct cooperative training exercises with Collin County emergency professionals, strengthening our preparedness and ensuring alignment with local first responders.

Secure Campus & Visitor Management

Our campus is monitored by a comprehensive security camera system, and we maintain strict identification procedures for all visitors and vehicles entering camp property. These measures help ensure that only authorized individuals are present on site, providing an added layer of protection for our campers and staff.

Carefully Screened & Highly Trained Staff

Every Lake Lavon Camp staff member and volunteer undergoes thorough background checks prior to serving. Beyond screening, we provide extensive training to ensure our team is prepared, attentive, and equipped to lead safely and responsibly.

Our facilities are routinely inspected by multiple regulatory agencies, including:
